Sweetser's 68 Sets a Record For Sleepy Hollow Course

SCARBOROUGH-ON-HUDSON, N. Y., Aug. 25.—Jess Sweetser, winner of the British amateur championship in 1926, played one of his most brilliant rounds since recovering from his recent illness when he covered the Sleepy Hollow Country Club course today in 68, breaking the course record of Archie Sanderson, the club professional, by two strokes. Sweetser's record-breaking round was four under par. Six birdies en route were mainly responsible. The outgoing trip required 36 shots, while on the homeward nine Sweetser took a 32.
